CAMP RULES



1. The Rendezvous will be from June $\mathbf{28}^{\text{th}}$ through July $\mathbf{2}^{\text{nd}}$. No persons should arrive earlier without special approval in advance.

2. THOSE ATTENDING CAMP MUST BE FCF MEMBERS AND BE CURRENT WITH CHAPTER DUES

3. Participants should strive to be in **FCF** attire soon after arrival and for the duration of the camp.

4. The era portrayed is the fur trapping period - 1750 to 1840.

5. NO HANDGUNS ARE ALLOWED AT ROYAL RANGER EVENTS.

6. No loaded firearms are allowed in camp! (this includes percussion caps!)

7. THERE ARE TO BE NO MODERN SHELTERS IN THE AREA DESIGNATED AS PRIMITIVE.

8. Lighting must be period as well. If you must have Coleman or electric lights, these are to remain inside your shelter.

9. All modern items such as water containers and coolers shall be covered in the primitive camping area. This will make photography much more authentic in appearance.

10. Your fires are your responsibility! Keep them under control. We will NOT have fires on the ground. Be prepared to bring Coleman stoves. Only Approved No Trace Fire Pits are allowed providing there isn 't a fire ban.

11. Ashes should be well soaked, dead out and placed in one central location, this spot will be announced at the camp.

12. Down, dead wood may be collected and burned.

13. FIRST AID WILL BE AVAILABLE AT TENTS MARKED BY A RED CROSS.

14. CAMPERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL THEIR ACTIONS.



CAMP RULES



15. Schedules and notices will be posted at the registration area.

16. Absolutely no animals or pets allowed in camp.

17. Leaders are responsible for the safety and well-being of the boys in their care. Be aware of where and what they are doing at all times.

17. All persons must register before being allowed to set up camp.

19. QUIET TIME IS FROM **11:00** PM TO DAYLIGHT. PLEASE BE COURTEOUS TO THOSE AROUND YOU.

20. All vehicles will come in on the service road, unload and drive vehicles back to parking lot. After camp is over, have your camp completely ready to load prior to bringing in your vehicle, quickly load and take vehicle back to the parking lot.

21. Shooting will be done only on the target range and the Black Powder Trail walk and under the watchful eye of our certified range officers.

22. All persons shooting a black powder firearm must have an approved "black powder card," from an NRA or NMLRA Black Powder Course.

23. All garbage and trash will be hauled away by **ALL**; we will clean the entire camp before you are allowed to leave.

24. All person's under 18 must have the "permission slip" signed by parent or guardian authorizing them to shoot and handle a firearm. Permission slip also covers Knife and Hawk

25. WE HAVE PORTA POTTY OUTHOUSES AND WATER IN THE MAIN CAMP AREA

26. Visitors are only allowed in camp from Noon to 7:00pm daily. Please abide by all of the rules.

27. All visitors will be accompanied by their respective adult FCF ' er.





SHOOTING RULES

1. 20- minute relays-5 minutes to post target only under the direction of the Range Officer.

2. HIP REST POSITION FOR OFF-HAND WILL BE ALLOWED.

3. FIREARMS TO BE LOADED AND CAPPED OR PRIMED ONLY ON THE FIRING LINE AND ONLY WHEN THE RANGE IS OPEN AND A RANGE MASTER ON DUTY.

4. THERE WILL BE NO PRACTICE TARGETS EXCEPT THOSE PRINTED ON THE 6-BULL.

5. Spotting scopes and binoculars are not allowed.

6. TARGETS MUST BE COMPLETED, ONCE POSTED, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF A MECHANICAL BREAKDOWN. THE RANGE OFFICER MUST BE NOTIFIED IF THERE IS A PROBLEM.

7. No loading directly from horn or flask. A Powder Measurer must be used always!

8. All targets for score may be posted at one time, as long as there is room to do so safely.

9. TARGETS MUST BE POSTED AS PRINTED.

10. All targets will be scored "ZERO" if blank or not turned in.

11. Shooting Glasses and Ear Protection are required!

12. YOUNG BUCKS MUST HAVE ADULT SUPERVISION IN THE SHOOTING AREAS.

13. CROSS-STICKS MAY BE DRIVEN INTO THE GROUND.

14. THE RANGE OFFICER MUST VERIFY ANY CROSS FIRING, DOUBLE HOLES, ETC., BEFORE THE TARGET IS PULLED.

15. Any POSSIBLE target must be verified and signed by the Range Officer before the target is pulled--unverified possible targets will be penalized 5 points. (Possible targets have all shots in the 10 ring)

16. Open iron sights only. (No shades or hoods)

17. PATCHED ROUND BALLS ONLY.



SHOOTING RULES



18. No artificial rest except where indicated. This includes cross sticks.

19. The Range Officers shall have full authority on the firing line at all times.

20. THE TERRITORIAL REP. AND HIS STAFF MAY RULE ON ANY UNEXPECTED EVENT.

21. All shooting boxes will be at least six feet from firing line.

22. No more than one competitor may use the same firearm in the same relay, or trail walk.

23. Every shooter must have an approved black powder card from an NRA or NMLRA Black Powder Course.

24. Young Bucks under **18** years of age must have a parent consent form signed by the parent or guardian allowing them to participate in shooting events.

25. Anything not covered under General Rules or Individual Range Rules will be governed by National Muzzle Loaders Rife Association regulation. Questions should be directed to the President and FCF Staff.

MARKING AND SCORING

All marking and scoring will be done in accordance with the National Muzzle Loading Rifle Association Rules & Regulations booklet, page 3, item C paragraph C-1 through C-15.





REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

All registration for territorial rendezvous will be online through AG Convention Service. The participants forms will be sent as links from the registration system to the adult or the parent to complete and sign via DocuSign. However, since all the forms will be sent out through the registration system, the registration system will receive the notification of the signed copies when they are complete.

Young Bucks (minors): Anyone who will be under age 18 as of July 2, 2023. If you will turn 18 before or during the event, you must register as an adult.

ONCE YOU CLICK ON THE URL FOR YOUNG BUCKS, YOU WILL SEE THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS:

As the designated Signer, you will receive an email inviting you to fill out the Parental Consent and Medical Treatment Authorization (PCA) form details for your minor Child. Once completed, you must click the yellow action button **FINISH** to fully submit the form (with a required CC to the designated Event Coordinator) so your child can get to participate in this RR Trappers FCF Territorial Rendezvous on June 29th through July 2^{ND.} 2023, in The Dalles, Oregon.

ONCE YOU'VE ELECTRONICALLY SIGNED AND SUBMITTED THE FORM SUCCESSFULLY, YOU WILL RECEIVE A FOLLOW-UP DOCUSIGN EMAIL CONFIRMATION. FROM THIS SECOND DOCUSIGN EMAIL, PLEASE ACCESS YOUR FULLY SIGNED FORM (ATTACHED TO IT) AND PRINT OUT ONE COPY OF ALL PAGES.

- GIVE ONE COPY TO THE LOCAL CHURCH'S EVENT LEADER WHO WILL RETAIN IT WHILE TRANSPORTING THE GROUP TO AND FROM (AND DURING) THE RENDEZVOUS.

OLD-TIMES (ADULTS): ANYONE WHO IS OVER AGE 18 OR WHO WILL TURN 18 ANYTIME DURING THE EVENT. ALL ADULTS WILL HAVE A 2-PART PROCESS FOR APPROVAL TO ATTEND RENDEZVOUS. THE FIRST PART IS COMPLETING THE ASSUMPTION OF RISK (AOR) FORM. THE SECOND PART IS A BACKGROUND CHECK RUN BY THE GENERAL COUNCIL OF THE ASSEMBLIES OF GOD. WITHOUT COMPLETING AND PASSING BOTH STEPS FOR ADULT APPROVAL, YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO ATTEND THE TERRITORIAL RENDEZVOUS.
